This task helps you practise **searching online**, **comparing information**, and **making a simple decision**.

Choose an Event

You need to travel by **train** to attend **ONE** of the events below.

Please **choose only one event**.

Event 1: Wellbeing Event

- **Location:** Manchester
- **Date:** Next Saturday
- **Time:** 12:00 pm – 4:00 pm

Event 2: Hiking Event

- **Location:** Birmingham
- **Date:** Next Saturday
- **Time:** 11:00 am – 3:00 pm

What you will practise

- Searching for train journeys
- Comparing journey times
- Making a simple choice
- Taking a screenshot as evidence
- Practising file upload



Task Instructions

Step 1: Decide which event to attend

1. Read the event details above
2. Choose **ONE** event
3. Decide which city you will travel to
 - Manchester **or** Birmingham



Step 2: Search for train journeys

4. Open a web browser (Chrome, Edge, or similar)
5. Go to a train website (for example: National Rail)
6. Search for trains:
 - From your nearest station
 - To the city of your chosen event

Step 3: Compare two journeys

7. Look at **two different train journeys**
8. Compare:
 - Journey time
 - Departure time
9. Decide which journey is **best for you**
(for example: quicker or better time)



Step 4: Take a screenshot (evidence)

10. Take a screenshot showing the **two journey options** (*Windows key + Shift + S*)
11. Make sure the journey times are visible

Step 5: Save your screenshot

12. Save the screenshot in:
Documents → Digital
